## **DIY Merriam Turkey Hunt in North Dakota**

Known as one of the *glamorous* sub-species for its distinctive white tail feathers, the Merriam Turkey is a must have for the Turkey hunter.

Details:

This hunt will be a DIY hunt but with guides from the Standing Rock Sioux Indian Tribe. Basically, they scout the birds, get you best possible position to harvest, but then it's up to you to call, use decoys, run & gun, etc and make the shot. 1 Tag gets you 2 birds so the hunt could be 1, 2 or 3 days max. I say Max since there are thousands of turkeys on this reservation. An NWTF friend of mine did this hunt 2 years ago and highly recommends this trip.
